2024 FOP Family Member Application

Applicants must:

1. Be an immediate family member (spouse, child, or sibling) or a direct dependent of a member of Battlefield Lodge #43 Fraternal Order of Police [Main Lodge (active or retired), Auxiliary or Associate Lodge].
2. Be able to produce and include a letter of acceptance from an accredited college, university, or vocational institute.
3. Be a full-time student pursuing an undergraduate degree.
4. If previously enrolled, must have successfully completed the previous year's studies with a GPA of 2.0 or better, and include proof with Application.

- There will be a minimum of one (1) **\$2,000.00 grant** awarded in July of 2024.
- Applications **MUST** be postmarked no later than **June 1, 2024**.

- The selection by the Grant Program Committee is conducted by a lottery system and is final.
- All candidates will be notified of the process results in June 2024
- Grant award will be made to the selected candidate(s) during July 17, 2024 Lodge meeting.
- Checks will be made payable jointly to attending college and scholarship recipient.
